

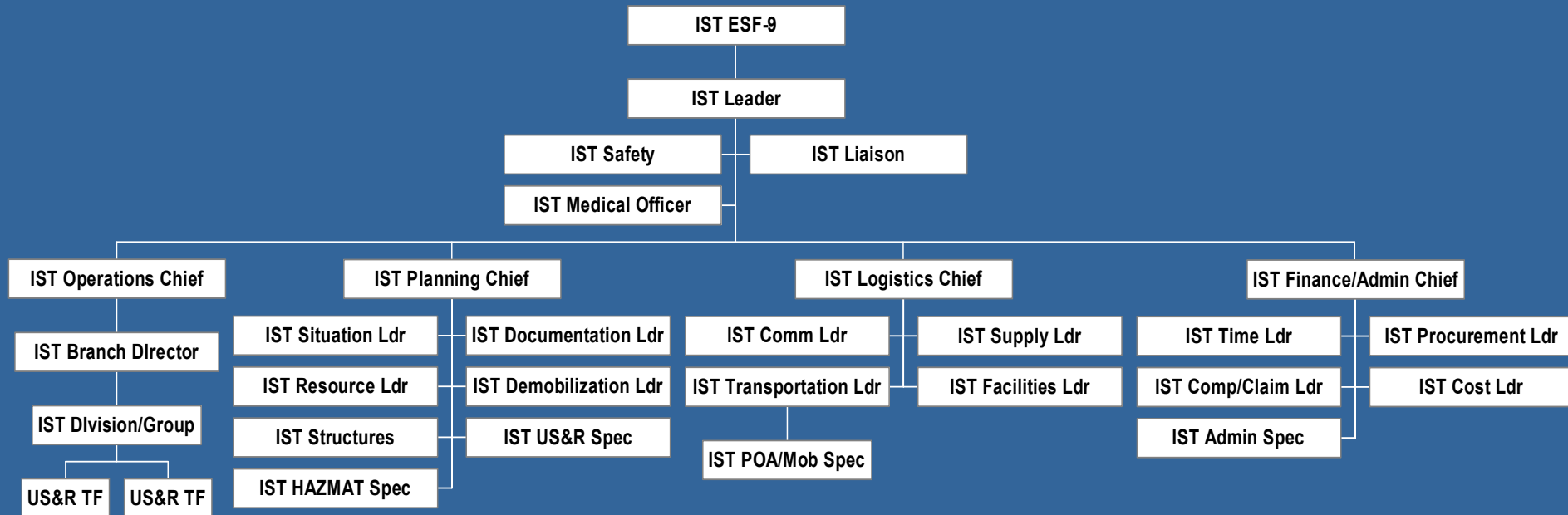

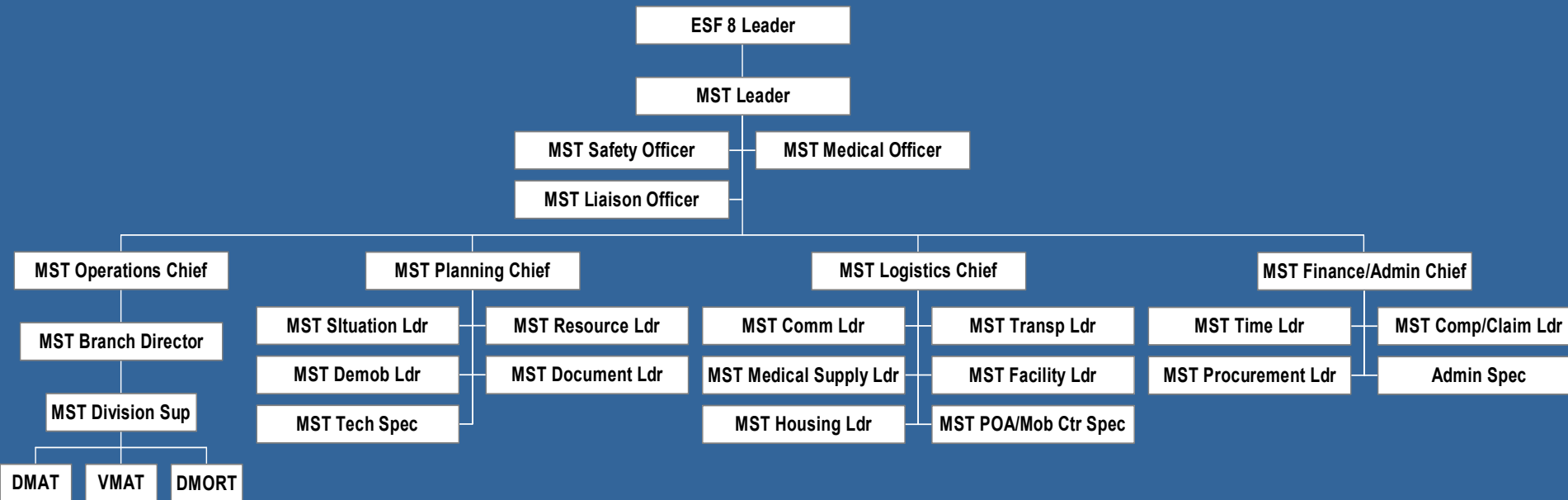

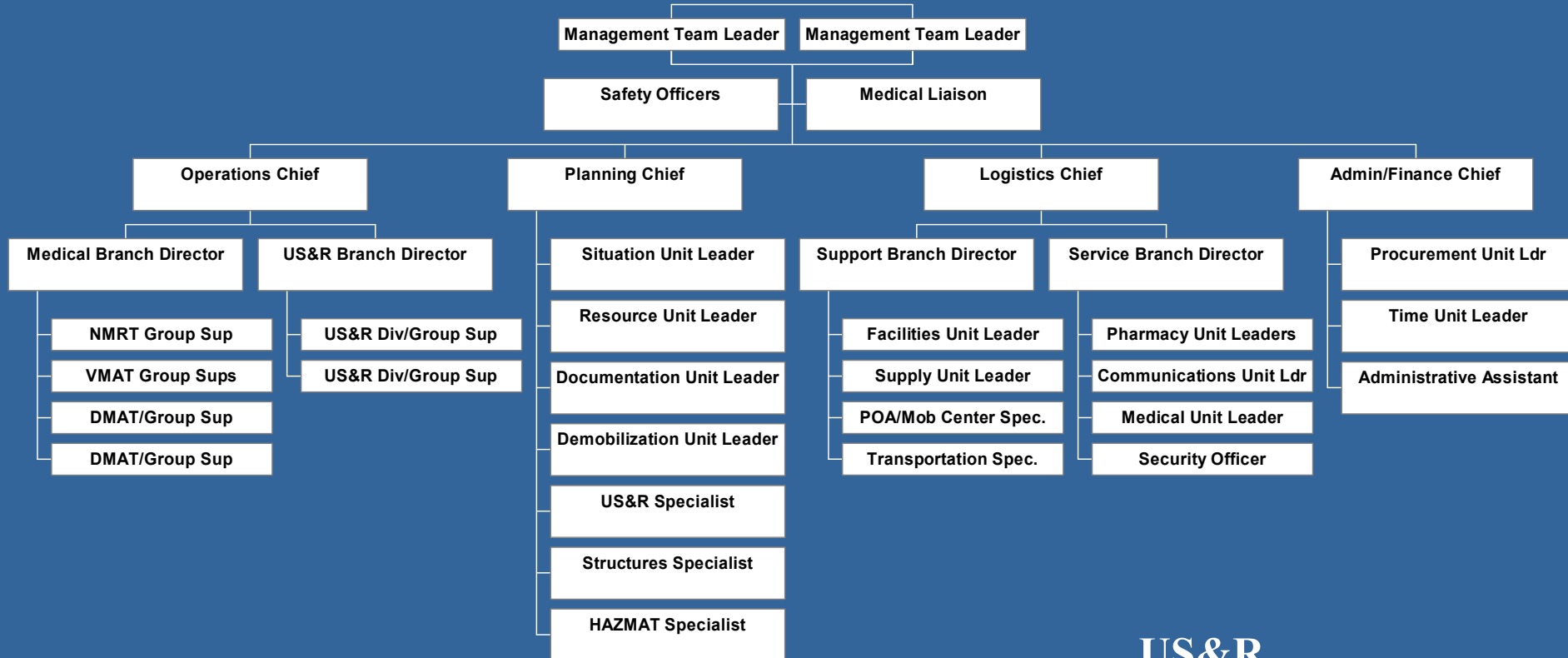

Systems Development

- Define mission
- Set system objectives and goals

- Define positions, position requirements, and develop job aides
- Train and exercise
- Provide mechanism for re-evaluation

ISTs and MSTs will stand up for any response that requires the deployment of US&R and NDMS teams and assets during the 2005 Hurricane Season.
